

CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK 2012

Anyone choosing not to participate in any of the following days must be in regular Hoban dress code.

Monday, January 30th - Color Day- Show your true *color!*

Students will dress in any one color of their choice.

- Students are encouraged to wear accessories, socks, shoes, pants, sweatpants, shirts, shorts (that pass the pop can test), skirts and dresses (that pass the pop can test) of all the same color.
- Dress must cover as much as normal dress code
- No spandex or other form-fitting or low cut clothing
- No jeans or flip flops

Tuesday, January 31st - Toga Day

Go back to Roman times with a festive toga. Guidelines:

- Students may use sheets to make a toga. Students may also wear gladiator-type sandals and Roman type headgear.
- Under the toga, athletic shorts or shorts that pass the pop can test must be worn as well as a Hoban t-shirt (other t-shirts NOT permitted.) Shoulders must be covered. Sweatpants may also be worn.
- No jeans, spandex, or other form-fitting clothing permitted.

Wednesday, Feb. 1st - "Where's Waldo Wednesday"

- Students are encouraged to dress as the character Waldo or Wanda
- Usual clothing would include a red and white striped shirt (or any colored stripes), a red and white cap, circular-rimmed glasses, and blue jeans.
- Jeans are to be clean and in good repair, only blue, and not low rise or skinny.
- Girls choosing to dress as Wanda may wear jean skirts that pass the pop can test.

Thursday, Feb. 2nd - Catholic Schools Day

- Wear t-shirt or sweatshirt from any Catholic grade school, Hoban, or Catholic college/university
- Normal dress code rules apply for waist down (NO jeans)

Friday, Feb. 3rd - Pajama Day

- Students may wear pajama pants or sweatpants and slippers
- Also acceptable: Hoban shirts, or cotton pajama shirt if part of a set and is modest
- No shorts, robes, tank-tops, or sleeveless shirts or nightgowns
- No spandex or other form fitting clothing
